Take Part Programmes overview

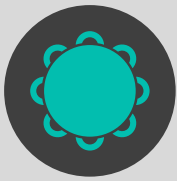
Our Take Part programme works with participants across East London and beyond, building creative skills, increasing confidence and making performance.

Our projects are co-designed and co-led by learning disabled professionals, and tailor-made to the access needs of all participants, so everyone who takes part can express their own creative voice.

Projects take place in arts venues, day centres, care homes, community centres and colleges.

Our community of participants ranges from age 16 to 83 and includes people of all genders and backgrounds.

From one-off workshops to long-term programmes, we work hard to ensure everyone feels welcome and valued.

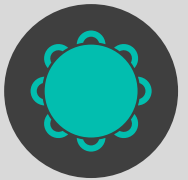


As a volunteer, you might:

- Welcome participants into the venue and be a friendly presence
- Take part in creative workshops, supporting participants' artistic ideas
- Provide access support for participants including note-taking and accessing sensory tools
- Support the devising of performances
- Perform alongside participants as on-stage creative support or in forum theatre workshop exercises

We provide:

- Enhanced DBS check and safeguarding training
- A taster session to see how you feel before committing to a term
- Support and information from our Take Part & Train team throughout your placement
- A short briefing before each session so you always know what's going on.

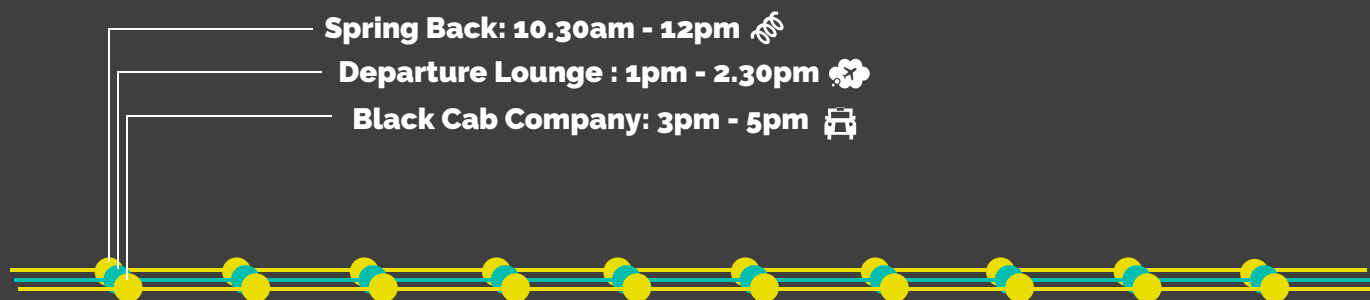
